## What does this mean for me as a student?

- All personal electronic devices will be turned off or placed on silent mode.
- Students with personal electronic devices cannot use them during school hours, extra curricular school activities and school family events.
- It is best if these devices stay at home, however, if students must have them for after school purposes, the personal electronic devices must be kept in the students backpack at all times.

## How can I reach my child if I need to contact them?

What will happen if my child has trouble making responsible choices in regards to the Personal Electronic Device student code of conduct?

If students are found with a device:

**child has trouble making** First time - teacher will take the device and return it at the end of the day. Parent contact will be made.

<u>Second time</u> - the device will be brought to the office and a parent will need to pick it up.

<u>Third time</u> - the device will be brought to the office and a meeting will be set up with parents to discuss how to best support the student in making responsible choices with their personal electronic device.
